Abandoned House Destroyed by Fire, One Person Injured

Slidell, LA. – St. Tammany Fire District #1 responded to the report of a structure fire across from 4291 Gum Dr., at the corner of Oak Dr. and Gum Dr. in Slidell. Firefighters arrived on the scene in less than 7 minutes to find a 1300 square foot home fully involved with fire.
