Resolution of Board of Commissioners of St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 1 Relating to Continuance of the Deductible Expense Offset for District Sponsored Employee Benefits for District No. 1

WHEREAS, a quorum of the Board of Commissioners ("Board") of St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 1 ("District") was present on this date for a properly advertised, regular meeting;

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the District, its employees, citizens and taxpayers to implement a program and procedure whereby the District has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to continue to establish an expense fund (Ref: BOC Resolution 2010-018) to self-insure the increasing cost of District Sponsored major medical insurance benefits for all active full time participating personnel for District No. 1;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The BOC wishes to continue the Deductible Expense Offset fund effective January 1, 2022 for District No. 1.
2. Benefit expense fund to include reimbursable expenses for Tier 4 prescription benefits. Personnel are responsible for prescription co-pay(s) and/or deductible equal to the BCBS FD Base Plan. Tier 4 prescription benefits eligible for expense reimbursement effective October 1, 2022.
3. Employee deductible & out of pocket maximum of \$2,000 with dependent deductible & out of pocket maximum of \$4,000 per

calendar year prior to deductible offset being engaged.

4. Benefit expense and Tier 4 prescription funding established at one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars effective January 1, 2023.
5. To the extent that prior resolutions or acts of this Board conflict with this Resolution those prior resolutions and actions are superseded by this Resolution.
